

“Scrambled Stars” Instructions

The Concept: Players will be shown a scrambled picture of a movie star and they'll have to guess which of the Hollywood elite it is.

Items Needed: Optional worksheet (included as a separate PDF).

Instructions: This game can be a team game or an individual game. To play it as an individual game, you should use the alternate slide show that is included in the presentation. It will show all of the scrambled photos in order and give all of the answers at the end. To use the alternate slide show, go to Slide Show → Custom Shows... → Show. If you use the alternate show, you should pass out the optional worksheets and have the players fill in the answers as the photos are shown.

To play Scrambled Stars as a team game, split your group into teams and play the normal slide show. This can be fun because the group has to decide together on an answer. When a team has the answer, you can choose how to have them show you they know it. You could have them raise their hand, stand up, run to the front, form a human pyramid, or whatever you want.

Scoring: One point for each correct answer. There's a tiebreaker if any of the teams are tied after the last question. There isn't a tiebreaker in the alternate individual slide show because so many of the players will most likely be tied at the end of the game.
