Q3. Name 2 of the Great Lakes

A3. Erie, Huron, Michigan, Ontario, Superior

Q4. Name 4 letters from the bottom row of a keyboard

A4. Z, X, C, V, B, N, M

Q5. Name 3 single syllable months

A5. March, May, June

Q6. Name 2 car brands with 5 letters in the name

A6. Honda, Chevy, Dodge, Mazda, Buick, Volvo, Acura, Isuzu, Lexus, Scion
