

## “Page Turner: Name Changers” Instructions

**The Concept:** Be the first to turn to the given verse and find what the Bible character had their name changed from or to.

**Items Needed:** A Bible

**Instructions:** If you have enough Bibles, this can be an individual game. If you are short on Bibles, have your group break into teams of two, three, four, etc, depending on how many Bibles you have. If your group is in teams, make sure the Bible rotates to a new person for each question.

A Bible character's name will appear at the top of the screen or the bottom. If it is at the top of the screen with an arrow coming from it, the answer will be what that person changed his/her name TO. If the name appears at the bottom of the screen with an arrow pointing to it, the answer will be what that person changed his/her name FROM. There is a four second pause built into the animation before the reference is shown. During this time, you could remind your group of what they are looking for. You could say, "Jacob's name was changed to..." and then wait for the reference to arrive and the pages to start turning. When it's the other way around, you could say, "Shadrach's name was changed from..." or "Shadrach used to be named..." First person to shout out the correct answer gets the point.

If you think your group is knowledgeable enough to know some of the answers (such as Daniel changing to Belteshazzar), you can require them to be the first to stand and start reading the verse, rather than have someone shout out the right answer before anyone gets a chance to try to find it in the Bible.

**Scoring:** One point for each correct answer. There's not a tiebreaker built into the game, but a quick and easy one would be to have the tied individuals or groups guess how many pages are in the leader's Bible. Closest answer wins.
