

“Artistic Impressions” Instructions

The Concept: Players will be shown paintings and have to figure out if they were painted by a professional artist, a toddler, or a chimpanzee.

Items Needed: Worksheet (included as a separate PDF file)

Instructions: This game can be a team game or an individual game. Pass out the worksheets and have the players circle the answer to each question as they are shown. The palette symbol represents a professional painter, the stick figure represents a toddler, and the chimpanzee represents... Well, if you can't figure it out, send us an e-mail. The answers are shown after the 13th painting. The paintings will change to show an artist, a kid, or a chimp painting the picture.

When you play the game as normal, all of the paintings are shown first and then the answers appear at the end. There is also an alternate version of the game included that will show who painted the picture right after it is shown on the screen. To use the alternate slide show, go to Slide Show → Custom Shows... → Show.

Scoring: One point for each correct answer. There is a tiebreaker at the end in case you've got some ties. The closest to the correct answer wins.
