

“Page Turner: Cried, Lied, Died” Instructions

The Concept: Be the first to turn to the given verse and find if the Bible character cried, lied, or died in the passage.

Items Needed: A Bible.

Instructions: If you have enough Bibles, this can be an individual game. If you are short on Bibles, have your group break into teams of two, three, four, etc, depending on how many Bibles you have. If your group is in teams, make sure the Bible rotates to a new person for each question.

A Bible character's name will appear at the top of the screen. After a couple of seconds a verse or set of verses will appear. The players will need to turn in their Bibles to the passage and read it to find out if the verse/s show the person listed to have cried, lied, or died. First person to shout out the correct answer gets the point.

You can require the players to be the first to stand and start reading the verse/s rather than have someone shout out a guess that is the right answer before anyone gets a chance to try to find it in the Bible.

Scoring: One point for each correct answer. There's not a tiebreaker built into the game, but a quick and easy one would be to have the tied individuals or groups guess how many Bibles are in the room. Closest answer wins.
