

We make plans... but what happens when those plans change?

...unexpected direction.

We know about unexpected change.

-Job change, passed over for promotion.

-Moving

-Loss – funerals

-Divorce

-Natural disaster

-Bad phone call

No one plans for these... but they happen.

Range from annoying to painful...

Slight change... to life altering

Frustration... to tragedy.

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;

⁶in all your ways submit to him, and he will DIRECT YOUR PATH.

It does not say – God controls your path.
God directs... influences... points the way.

God's detours save us from destruction.

Construction

This road is not ready yet.

Sometimes when we pray, God says NO... YES... or NOT YET.

God's detour is often a NOT YET.

Pastor Brian – Week 2 - Exodus Israel
Wilderness

“What should have taken 11 days from the

Red Sea to Promise land... took 40 years”
Obedience issues caused detours.

Detours of construction are NOT YET
messages from God.

- The situation might not be ready...
- Other people may not be ready...

Instruction

There are lessons for you to learn.

Sometimes it is not external situations or
people that need to change... Sometimes it
is us.

Detours delay... “WHAT IS TAKING SO
LONG” “WE SHOULD BE THERE BY NOW”

David anointed next King (10 yrs)

David defeats Goliath (13 yrs)

FAST TRACK BABY – THERE IN NO TIME

David finally becomes King 17 years later
(30 yrs)

Lessons were learned along the way.
Construction delays prepare the situation.
Instruction delays prepare us through
lessons.

Introduction Detours – God causes you to
change course to come in contact with
others.

Jesus detours – goes out of the way to
travel to Samaria to minister to the woman
at the well. (John 4)

Jesus detours – gets on a boat and sails
through a storm to meet a demon
possessed man in Gadarene. (Mark 5)

Phillip travels into the dessert to baptize the
Ethiopian man. (Acts 8)

Paul & Silas remain in their jail cell to save the Philippian Jailer. (Acts 16)
