## Twisted 3 – Scripture Misused: 1 Corinthians 14:34

Welcome to Redemption Church! My name is Chris Fluitt. I am the lead pastor here at Redemption.

We are in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of our Twisted series. We have looked at Jeremiah 29:11, and Romans 9, and this week we will look at another twisted Scripture... but first...

Let's remind you of our working definition for **Twisted Scripture** – To alter the meaning of a scripture passage from its original intent.

The idea of twisting scripture is actually in the Bible.

2 Peter 3:16 (NIV) (Speaking of Paul) His letters contain some things that are hard to understand, which ignorant and unstable people distort, as they do the other Scriptures, to their own destruction.

The word for “distort” is translated as “twist” in many versions of Bible translations. **Twisting Scripture leads people to destruction (2 Peter 3:16) but the words of Jesus bring Life (John 6:63).**

Jesus said in John 6:63 ...the words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life.(NIV)

Get your Bibles out... or your smartphone app and join us in 1 Corinthians 14:34...
